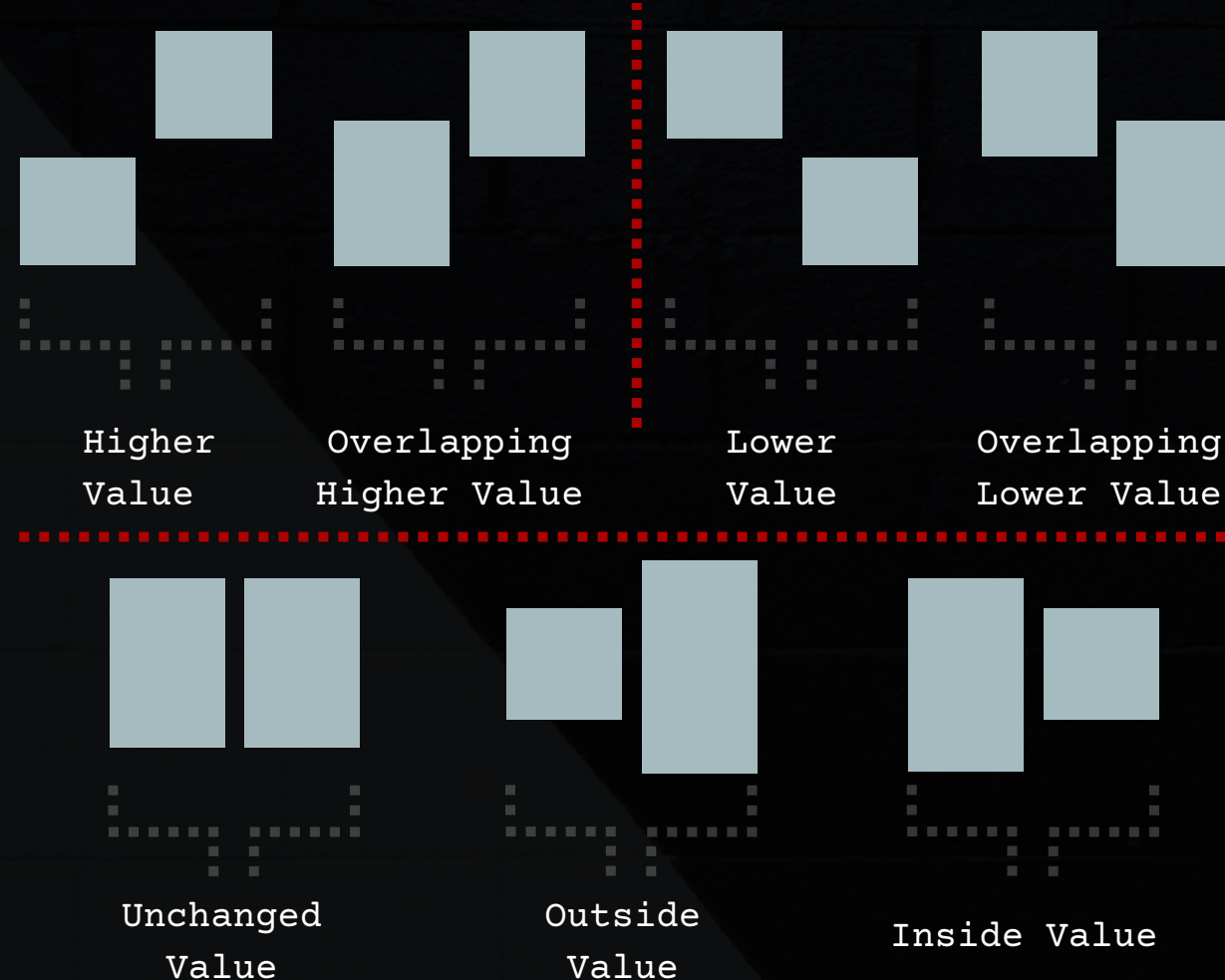


Higher Value	Bullish

2-Day Pivot Relationship *S3 to R3

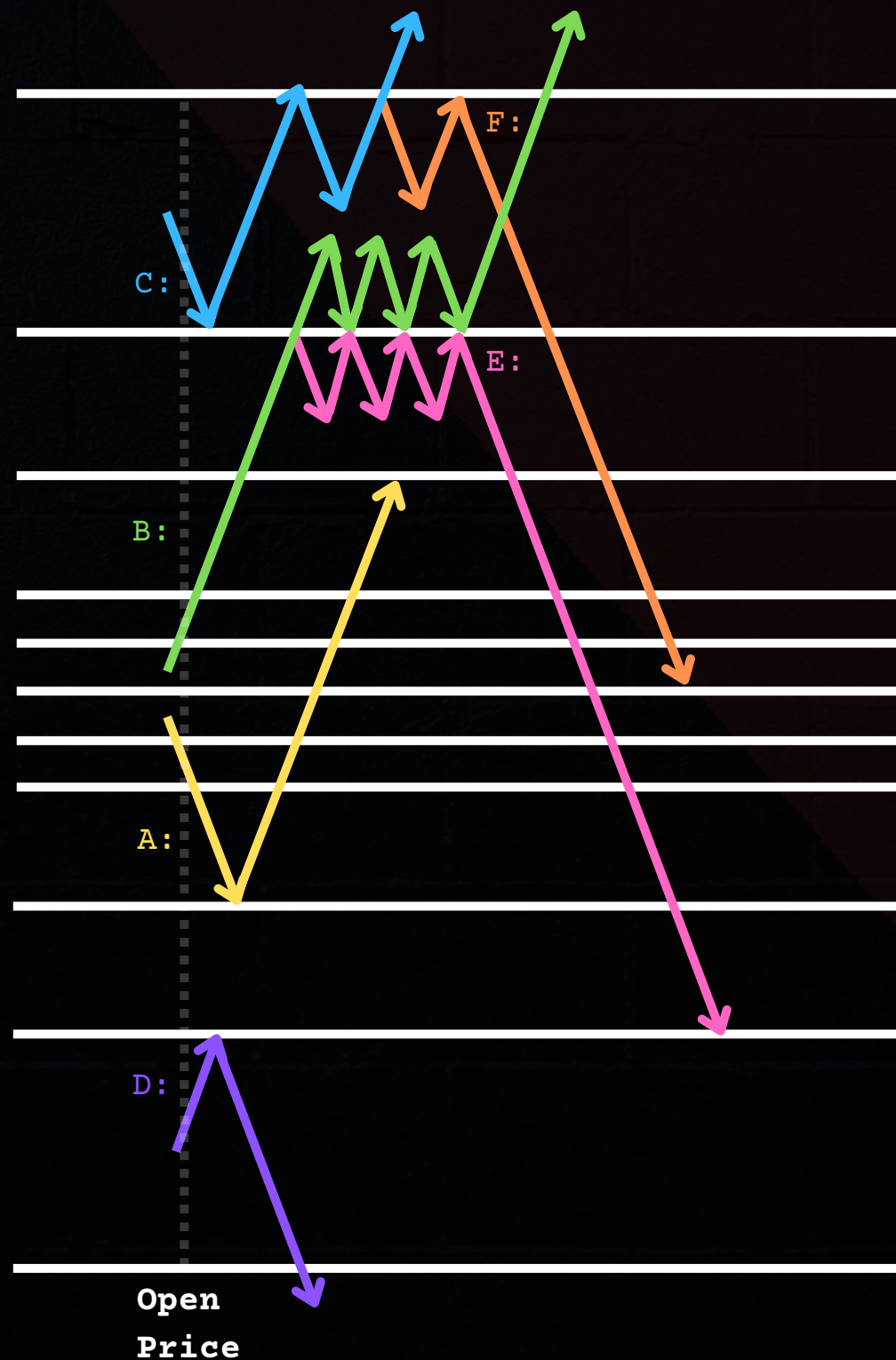

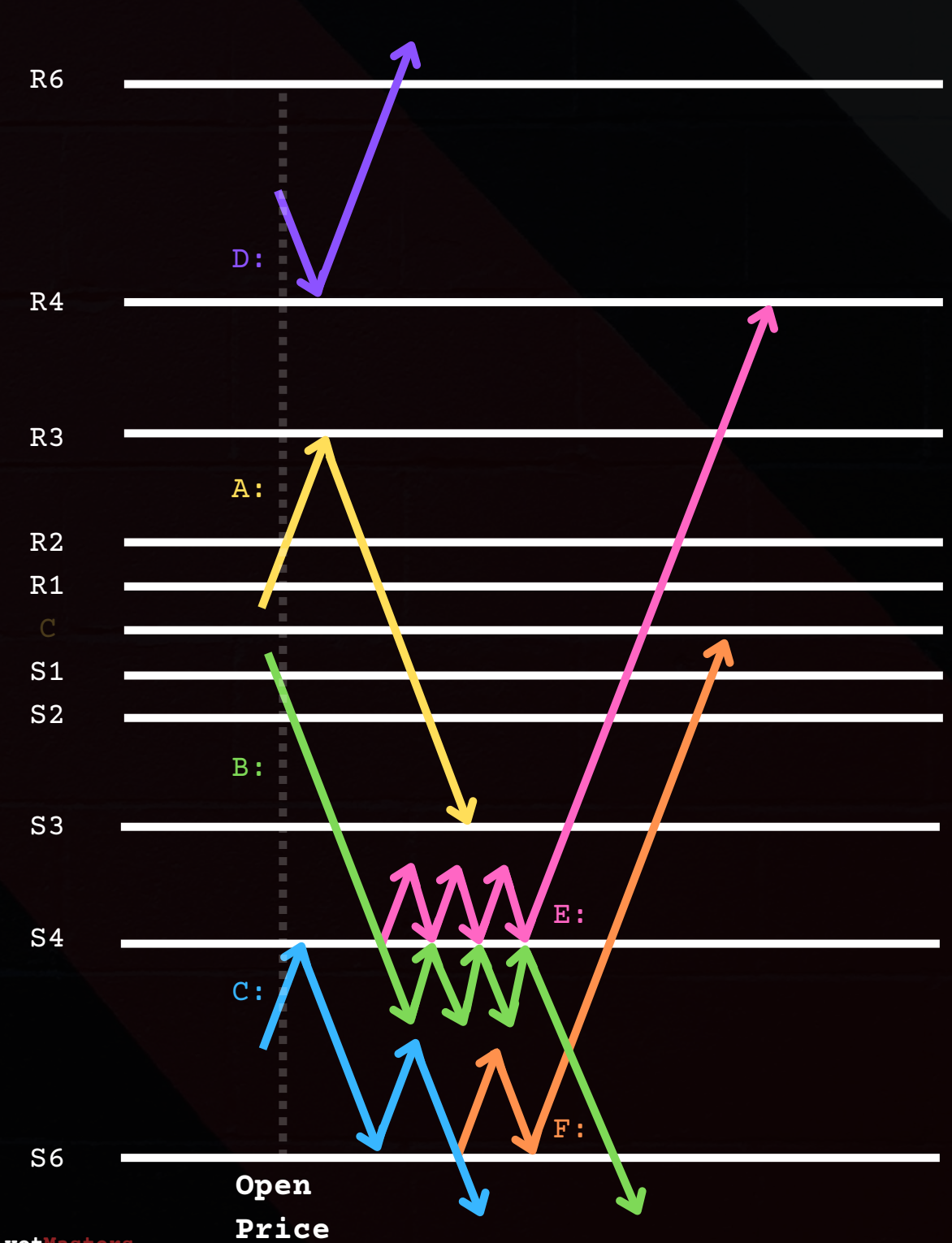
Trend Long

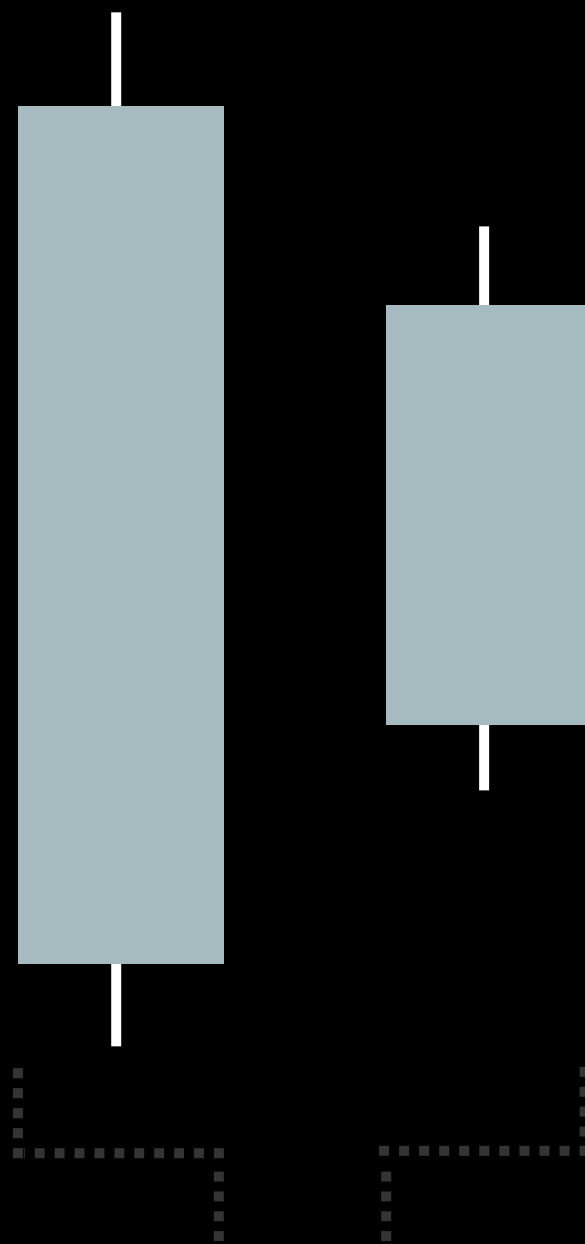
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When to Use PreMarket Data with your Camarilla Pivots

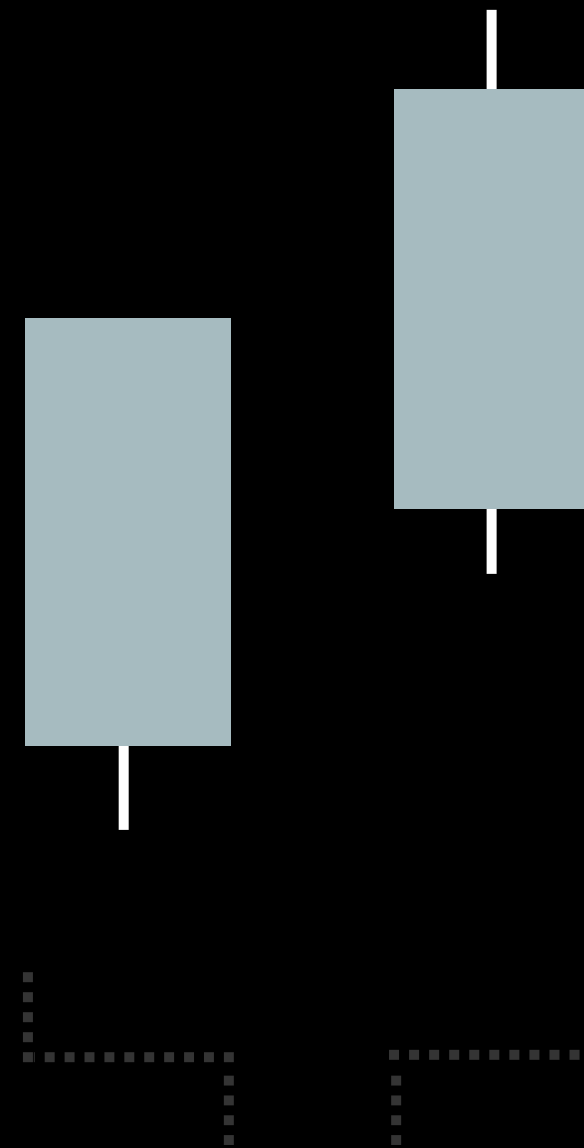

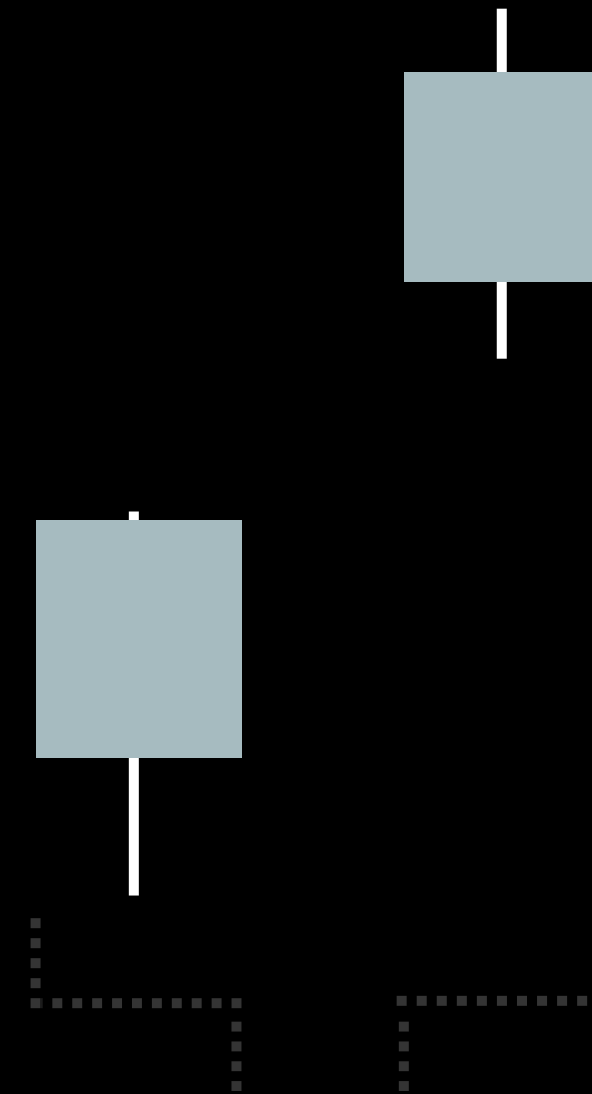
High and Low of current premarket activity is within the High and Low of the previous session.

With



High or Low of current premarket activity overlaps Either the High or Low of the previous session

With



High and Low of current premarket activity is gapped out from previous sessions High or Low

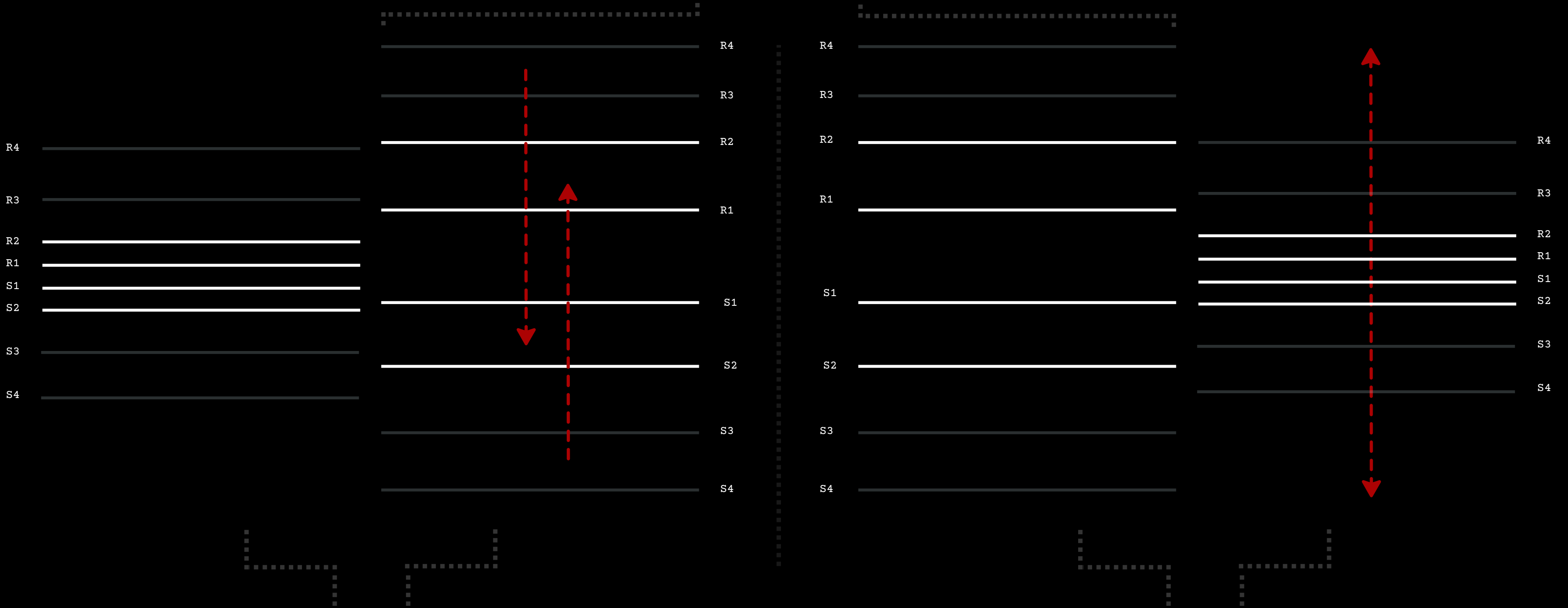
Inside Day or Outside Day



Inside Day

Pivots with a similar sized central range (S2-R2) should be viewed as neutral, indecisive, or choppy.

Outside Day



An inside day (Outside Value) is marked with a central pivot range (S2-R2) that is significantly wider than the range of the previous session. Trade Bias should be towards the center of the range.

An Outside day (Inside Value) is marked with a central pivot range (S2-R2) that is significantly narrower than the range of the previous session. Trade Bias should be away from the central range.

You must always cut your losers and let your winners run. Different trading edges require different risk management strategies.
