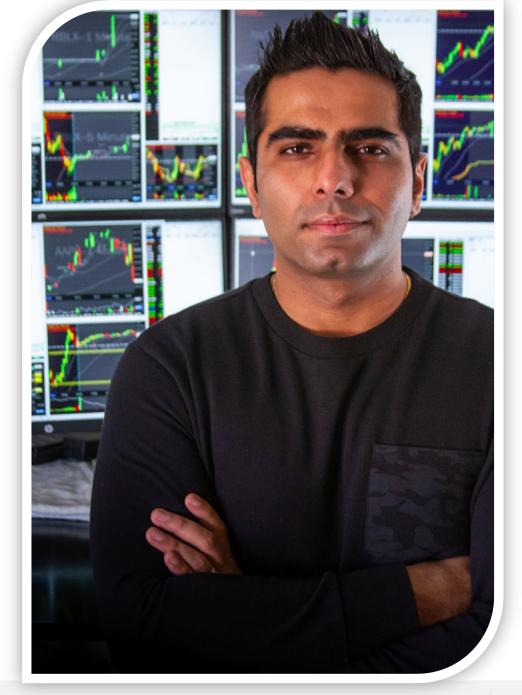

"Recycling shares" and "Trading around the Core"

• "Recycling shares" typically refers to a trading strategy where traders repeatedly buy and sell shares of the same stock over time. Instead of maintaining a static position in a particular stock, traders actively trade in and out of it, potentially generating profits through multiple transactions.

• Trading around the core is a strategy where traders maintain a core position in a particular stock while actively Recycling Shares around the core position to capitalize on short-term opportunities. In this approach, the core position represents a long-term thesis, while the recycling of shares around it involves taking advantage of short-term price movements to enhance returns.

- Has a clear entry and exit plan based on R/R.



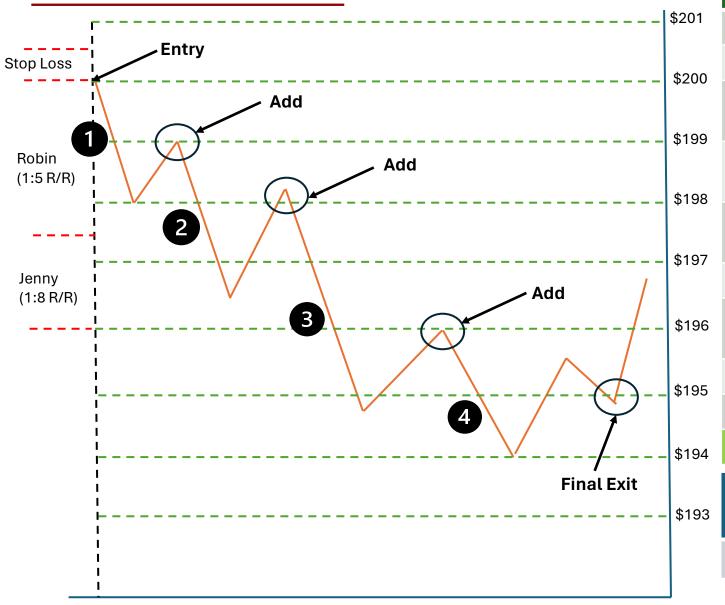
Jenny

- Also has a clear entry and exit plan based on R/R.



Adam

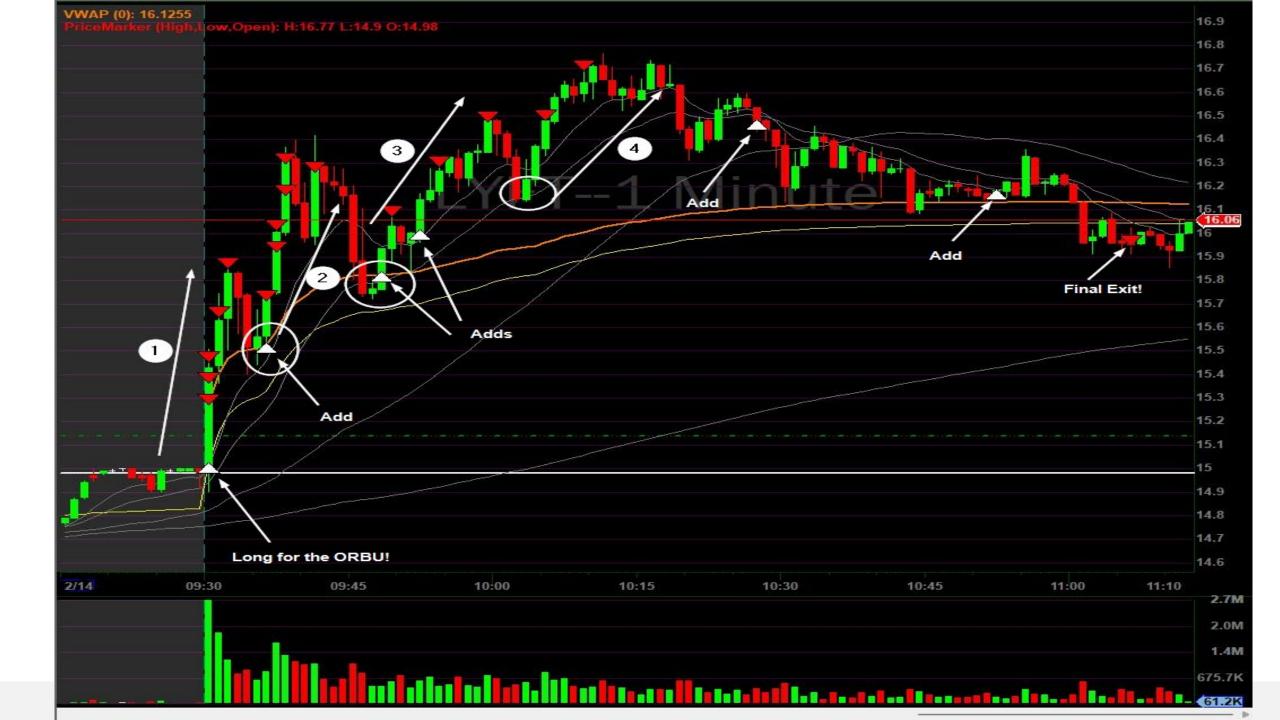
- Trades based on variable R/R.
- Has a mindset of keeping the register ringing and is aggressive in profit takings and recycling.
- Has a defined entry but relies on price action and trend change for the exits.

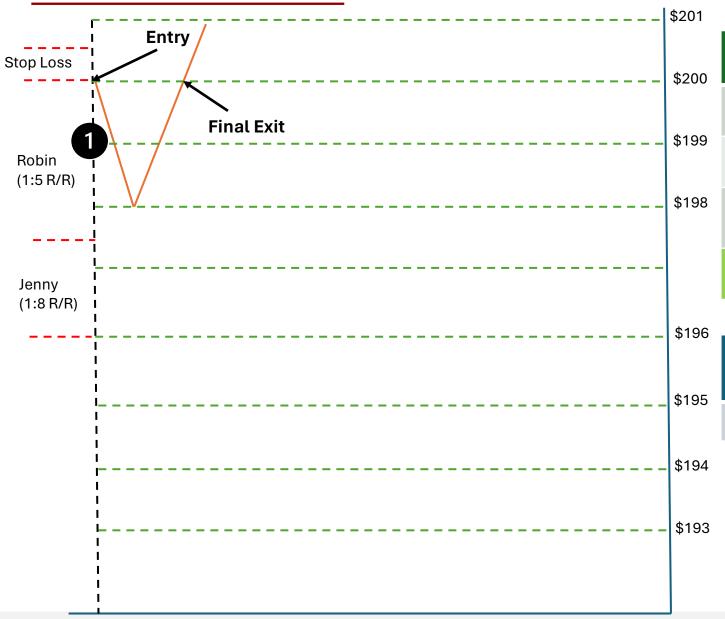
